Pope: Stop war in Ukraine and hunger in Gaza, may hostages be freed



As he arrived at the Villa Barberini in Castel Gandolfo, Pope Leo XIV spoke about ceasefire talks for Ukraine, a resolution of the humanitarian crisis in Gaza, and the release of Israeli hostages.

When asked what he expects from the summit between U.S. President Donald Trump and Russian President Vladimir Putin, Leo XIV replied: "We must always seek a ceasefire. The violence, the many deaths, must stop. Let's see how they can come to an agreement. Because after all this time, what is the purpose of war? We must always seek dialogue, diplomatic efforts, not violence, not weapons."
