Lord Alton of Liverpool writes on the upcoming vote on Kim Leadbeater's Assisted Suicide Bill on Friday 29th November, "Our nation stands on the brink of a major change in how we treat human life, particularly the lives of the most vulnerable. If this radical proposal to introduce assisted suicide passes, thousands of vulnerable lives will be at risk over the coming years.

Mounting evidence from the small number of places around the world that have legalised assisted suicide shows, that these laws are incremental, that safeguards do not work, and that

the changed law can have devastating consequences." It is therefore vital that this dangerous Assisted Suicide Bill is defeated on Friday 29th November. Please urgently send this postcard enclosed in newsletter to your MP urging them to vote against this Bill on the 29th November. This will make a profound difference.
