Fund When active ministry ceases, Diocesan priests live independently in retirement. Priests generally retire at 75, often after having given 40-50 years of service to the people of the Diocese - well beyond the retirement age of most lay people. As they live independently priests are unable to rely upon the financial support provided by the parish. Priests receive a minimal wage during their years in active ministry and so most only receive the basic state pension upon retirement. As a response to this, the Retired Priests' Fund seeks to help sick and retired priests with their basic living needs, providing a pension, accommodation etc... Our priests rely on what the fund provides after devoting their lives to furthering the mission of the Church and bringing people closer to Christ. The Card machine will also accept donations
