PREGO LEAFLET

**The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ
(Corpus Christi)
Year C, Sunday 22nd June 2025**

'This is my body, which is for you'

The feast of Corpus Christi honours Jesus Christ, who is truly made
present to us through the bread and wine. We celebrate also the
Church as the living Body of Christ in all its humanity and messiness.
Melchizedek, the king of Salem and a high priest, brings bread and
wine and blesses Abram after Abram's victory in battle. This foretells
Jesus's ultimate sacrifice of himself, and of how we are united with him
through the Eucharist. **(First Reading)**

The **Psalm** continues with this theme, proclaiming the destiny of Jesus
as saviour, overcoming sin, evil and death for all.

In the **Second Reading**, Paul is responding to reports of the
Corinthians' inappropriate and abusive behaviour, particularly during
the celebration of the Eucharist. His retelling of the Last Supper is a
reminder of the sacredness and unity of the sacrament and the need to
honour Jesus's great sacrifice.

The **Gospel** recounts the miracle of the loaves and fishes. The food
multiplies as it is handed from person to person, reminding us that
God's love is to be shared with others and is abundant.

As **Pilgrims of Hope** in this Jubilee year, we pray that we will be united
in the healing power of God's unending love. Through sharing
in the Eucharist, we are provided with the living bread that
gives us strength and nourishment for all of life's struggles.
