Bambinelli Sunday - 14th Dec 09.30 Mass 3rd Sunday of Advent

The beautiful Advent Tradition, Bambinelli Sunday, was instituted by St Pope John Paul II. The tradition follows that on the 3rd Sunday of Advent children & adults bring their Baby Jesus figures from their homes to St Peters Square where they are blessed by the Pope. This year we will celebrate "Bambinelli Sunday" at our 9.30am Mass on Sunday, December 14th. All are invited to bring the Baby Jesus figure from their homes to Mass that morning to be blessed. Families can even make their own "bambinelli" if they want.

A suggestion is, following the blessing, take your "bambinelli" home and place it in a gift box, wrap it, and save it for Christmas. Let this be the first gift your family opens on Christmas, when together you place your Baby Jesus figure in the crib, and have a home blessing of the Nativity for your whole family.




