Bambinelli Sunday - 15th Dec 09.30 Mass 3rd Sunday of Advent

The beautiful Advent Tradition, Bambinelli Sunday, was instituted by St Pope John Paul II. The tradition follows that on the 3rd Sunday of Advent children & adults bring their Baby Jesus figures from their homes to St Peters Square where they are blessed by the Pope. Parishes around the world now join in the celebration, encouraging young children to make the connection between the Nativity set at home and the local church where they worship. A suggestion is, following the blessing, take your 'Bambinelli' home and open it as a family on Christmas morning where the youngest member of the family would place it in the crib. A gift of the presence of Christ in your home this Christmas.

This year we will celebrate 'Bambinelli Sunday' on 15th December at the 9.30 am Mass and the children will make a Baby Jesus in Liturgy Group
